## **NAA Director Meeting Minutes**

Sunday, June 4, 2023

Meeting called to order at 2:00 PM at the Homefront, North Bend, NE. Roll call conducted, 14 out of 19 directors present.

March 5, 2023 minutes read aloud by Jessica Fetrow and discussed. Motion to approve March minutes was made by Todd Bailey. Second by Jim Cantor. Approved unanimously.

Financial report was provided to those present, reviewed and discussed.

- A motion was made by Kirk Westring to move \$100,000 into a CD with Edward Jones at an estimated rate of 5.5%. Second by Marty Reznicek. Approved unanimously.
- Motion to approve financial report was made by Matt Shaw. Second by Kirk Westring. Approved unanimously.

#### **Old Business:**

Decision was made to wait to dredge the pond at the Homefront until the fall.

Dave Mitchell has provided the language to include in the NAA by-laws to allow the association to remove a member should the association see fit. This was read aloud by Randy Fetrow and discussed. Directors agreed that the amendment is appropriate. This will be voted on at the next regular meeting in order for the by-laws to be officially amended.

Veteran's Ride (July 15th)

- Michael and his organization, Uplifting Warriors would like to be involved with the Veteran's Ride. He has offered to have tank tops made and would like to donate them to the NAA to be handed out at the event.
- Wounded Warriors has reached out and would like to attend the event. They have also agreed to share the event on their Facebook page.
- Pillen is no longer able to provide pork like previously discussed.

Tim Noonan will be getting 80 pounds of beef this year for the event. Marty Reznicek has lined up picnic tables. Jay Kern will work with some others to have the flags on the bank again this year.

- Discussed options for loading people onto boats this year depending on water level, sandbars, etc. This will likely be a last minute decision the week before or week of the event depending on the conditions.
- A 'last minute clean up' will be held at the Homefront the Wednesday before.

Randy let everyone know that the NAA's insurance representative plans to attend the September meeting to answer any questions and run through what our policy covers at the Homefront.

#### **New Business:**


Marine permits were discussed and it's recommended that the NAA apply for this when events are held on the river. This will include the Veteran's Ride, Poker Run, etc.

Columbus Run t-shirts were discussed. Kirk Westring asked for feedback regarding how to handle sponsorships with the t-shirts. It was suggested and agreed upon that the NAA will take 10 sponsors on the shirt, which will include the sponsor's logo. Logo spots will be \$250. There will also be 10 sponsors listed on the t-shirts without the sponsor logo. Non-logo spots will be \$100.

The concern with non-members using the Homefront was brought up and discussed. Several times, non-members have been found to be using the Homefront without a member present. Guests are allowed at the Homefront but an NAA member must accompany them. A reminder will be posted on the Facebook page.


A motion to adjourn was made by Marty Reznicek. Second by Lynden Rathie.



The best part was seeing nothing left but footprints on the sand as air boaters are very responsible when litter is concerned.




## **AIRBOATER'S CODE of ETHICS**

- 1. I will respect the rights of all users of the recreational waterways of the state, on public waters and on adjacent private property.
- 2. I will be considerate and courteous at public vessel launch ramps and docks. In an effort to not delay others, I will launch and retrieve my vessel promptly.
- 3. I will always operate at a safe speed in posted "No Wake" zones.
- 4. When approaching the shoreline, I will be especially aware of swimmers and other water vessels near the shoreline.
- 5. I realize that my vessel's equipment, ability, weather conditions, and especially other vessel traffic should determine my vessel speed.
- 6. In case of an emergency, I will volunteer assistance.
- 7. I am aware that my vessel creates air propeller wash and will use idle speed near the shoreline and in close proximity to boat launch ramps.
- 8. I will ensure that all passengers in my vessel are equipped with safety equipment, including life vests, ear protection, eye protection, and required safety equipment.
- 9. I will avoid unnecessary disturbance of wildlife and will not enter posted "No Trespass" areas.
- 10. I will pay close attention to the engine sound levels that my vessel may create and be aware of how others on vessels and on the shoreline will react to it.
- 11. I will not litter and will bring back all trash. I will be careful in handling my fuel.
- 12. I will not interfere with or harass others.

  I realize that people will judge all airboaters by my individual actions.
