

### **NAA Director Meeting Minutes**

#### December 10th, 2023

Meeting called to order at 2:02 PM at Beer 30 Bar, Chapman, NE. Roll call conducted, 18 out of 19 directors present.

September 10, 2023 minutes were read aloud by Jessica Fetrow. Motion to approve September minutes was made by Matt King, second by Marty Reznicek. Approved unanimously.

Financial report was provided to directors, reviewed, and discussed. Motion to approve financial report made by Wade Wagner, second by Jim Kantor. Approved unanimously.

#### **Old Business:**

Updated copies of bylaws were provided to all directors present.

Annual meeting (February 2nd, 2024)

- The Ramada has changed the cost of the meal per plate since last year significantly. The meal at the 2023 meeting cost \$22/plate with the NAA charging \$20/plate and paying the remaining \$2/plate. The meal will now cost \$29/plate plus gratuity and taxes. Directors discussed this increased price and whether or not to have the meal at the 2024 meeting with the price increase. Directors discussed pros and cons.
  - o A motion was made by Kirk Westring to charge members \$25/plate and the NAA pay the rest of the cost/plate, second made by Matt King. Before voting on this motion, Randy also let directors know that the band, "Swiped Right", that performed at the 2023 meeting recently backed out and is now not available for the 2024 meeting. They recommended a band that may be available however the cost of this band to play is \$1,500, significantly more than "Swiped Right" charged. After learning this additional information, Kirk Westring rescinded his motion regarding the meal.
  - o Discussion continued regarding alternative options given the meeting is two months away. A motion was made to not offer

- the catered meal at the 2024 annual meeting due to cost, but continue to talk with the Ramada about other cost effective food options including reserving the hospitality room. The motion was made by Mark Ulferts, second by Kirk Westring. Motion passed by majority vote.
- Directors agreed that they would still like to see some kind of entertainment after the meeting. A motion was made to continue seeking entertainment options, not to exceed \$1,500. This motion was made by Mark Ulferts, second by Lynden Rathje.
   Motion passed by majority vote.
- Randy shared with directors their assigned tasks during the annual meeting. These are just a guideline and can be adjusted as needed.

#### **New Business:**

Directors were encouraged to seek out other venue options for the 2025 annual meeting. Although the meeting has been held at the Ramada in Columbus for several years, there is no contract signed for 2025 yet. The 2025 annual meeting will also be the NAA's 30th anniversary.

Dredging the Home front pond has not happened yet as they are waiting for frost

New apparel company discussion was tabled until a later date.

Motion to adjourn meeting made by Kirk Westring, second by Dustin Feyerherm. Meeting adjourned at 2:49 PM.








### **Looking Back...**


### **AIRBOATER'S CODE of ETHICS**

- 1. I will respect the rights of all users of the recreational waterways of the state, on public waters and on adjacent private property.
- 2. I will be considerate and courteous at public vessel launch ramps and docks. In an effort to not delay others, I will launch and retrieve my vessel promptly.
- 3. I will always operate at a safe speed in posted "No Wake" zones.
- 4. When approaching the shoreline, I will be especially aware of swimmers and other water vessels near the shoreline.
- 5. I realize that my vessel's equipment, ability, weather conditions, and especially other vessel traffic should determine my vessel speed.
- 6. In case of an emergency, I will volunteer assistance.
- 7. I am aware that my vessel creates air propeller wash and will use idle speed near the shoreline and in close proximity to boat launch ramps.
- 8. I will ensure that all passengers in my vessel are equipped with safety equipment, including life vests, ear protection, eye protection, and required safety equipment.
- 9. I will avoid unnecessary disturbance of wildlife and will not enter posted "No Trespass" areas.
- 10. I will pay close attention to the engine sound levels that my vessel may create and be aware of how others on vessels and on the shoreline will react to it.
- 11. I will not litter and will bring back all trash. I will be careful in handling my fuel.
- 12. I will not interfere with or harass others.

  I realize that people will judge all airboaters by my individual actions.
