NAA Director Meeting Minutes

December 8, 2024

Meeting called to order at 2:01 PM at Country Drive Golf Course in Ashland, NE. Roll call conducted, 17 of 21 directors present.

September 8th, 2024 minutes were read aloud by Jessica Fetrow. Motion to approve September minutes was made by Matt Shaw, second by Marty Reznicek. Approved unanimously.

Financial report provided to directors, reviewed, and discussed. Motion to approve financial report made by Jay Kern, second by Mark Kreikemeier. Approved unanimously.

Old Business:

Randy Fetrow has been working on a 30th anniversary t-shirt design, but nothing has been finalized. Any input from the directors is welcome.

Shipping Container

A budget of up to \$3,500.00 was approved at the September 2024 meeting. Wade Wagner and Jay Gould will work together to purchase and deliver the shipping container to the Homefront.

Annual Meeting 2025

- Food/Beer- Jay Gould has access to a refrigerated van that the NAA can use to help store beer. Wade Wagner has been able to get half of the meat for the dinner donated to the NAA, he would like to try to get the other half donated and will continue to work on this.
- Game & Parks donation- \$750.00 will be donated to Game & Parks. Motion to approve was made by Todd Bailey, second by Jay Gould. Approved unanimously.
- Ten vendors will have the opportunity to set up and advertise at the meeting this year. It will cost \$250.00 for a vendor to set up or \$100.00 if they sponsored t-shirts or the calendar in 2024.
- Bar will be cash only and the Nielson Center should have a fountain pop machine available to use. Buckets to use for beer will also be available.
- The NAA should be able to take credit cards for memberships and auction items this year. Everything else will continue to be cash/check.
- Directors will be needed to help set up Friday night.
- Directors had the option of two bands to provide entertainment later in the evening. Jessica Fetrow made a motion to hire "Lost County Road," second by Kyle Kern. Approved unanimously.

New Business:

Director, Jim Kantor passed away and the NAA received \$1,075.00 in his memory as requested by Jim before he passed.

Randy let directors know that the Highway 81 bridge at Columbus is scheduled to be replaced. Construction is set to begin this spring, and they are supposed to leave a "hole" to allow airboat traffic to continue to pass through.

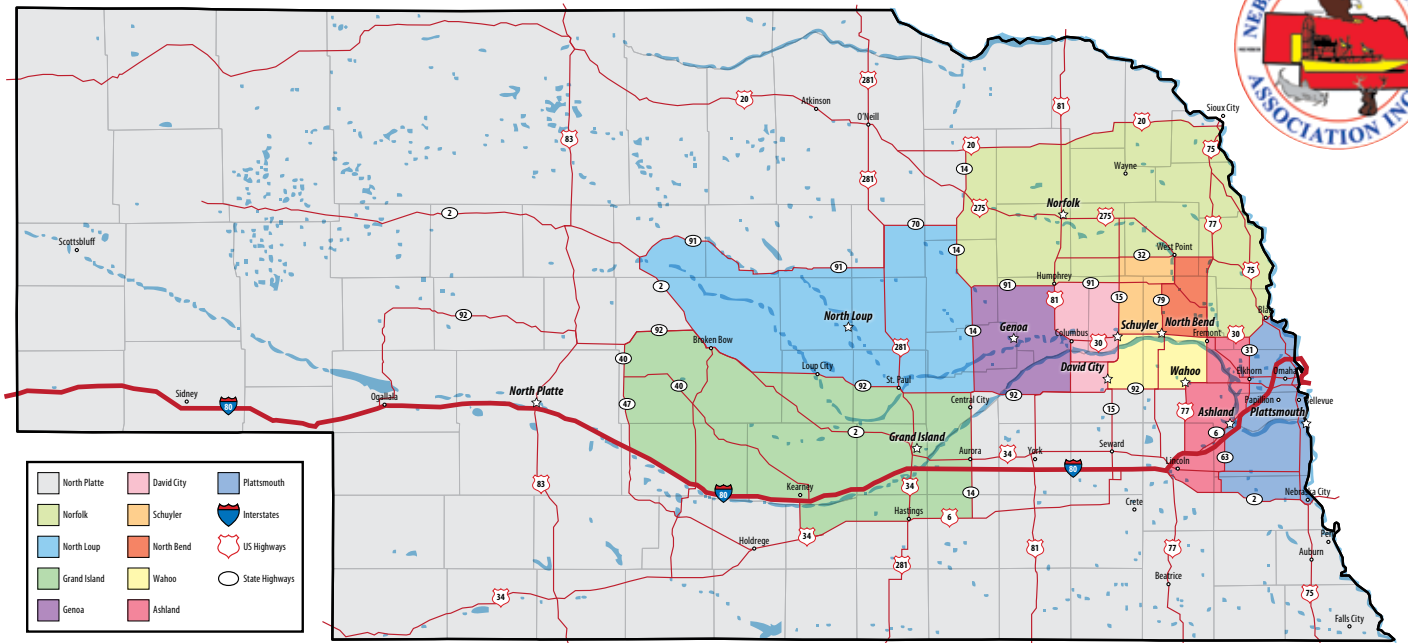

AIRBOATER'S CODE *of* ETHICS

1. I will respect the rights of all users of the recreational waterways of the state, on public waters and on adjacent private property.
2. I will be considerate and courteous at public vessel launch ramps and docks. In an effort to not delay others, I will launch and retrieve my vessel promptly.
3. I will always operate at a safe speed in posted "No Wake" zones.
4. When approaching the shoreline, I will be especially aware of swimmers and other water vessels near the shoreline.
5. I realize that my vessel's equipment, ability, weather conditions, and especially other vessel traffic should determine my vessel speed.
6. In case of an emergency, I will volunteer assistance.
7. I am aware that my vessel creates air propeller wash and will use idle speed near the shoreline and in close proximity to boat launch ramps.
8. I will ensure that all passengers in my vessel are equipped with safety equipment, including life vests, ear protection, eye protection, and required safety equipment.
9. I will avoid unnecessary disturbance of wildlife and will not enter posted "No Trespass" areas.
10. I will pay close attention to the engine sound levels that my vessel may create and be aware of how others on vessels and on the shoreline will react to it.
11. I will not litter and will bring back all trash.
I will be careful in handling my fuel.
12. I will not interfere with or harass others.
I realize that people will judge all airboaters by my individual actions.
