



PLATTE RIVER PALLID STURGEON PROJECT

Pallid Sturgeon is a long-lived native fish that can live over 50 years and has been around since the time of the dinosaurs over 70 million years ago. Historically, Pallid Sturgeon could be found throughout the lower Mississippi and Missouri rivers as well as their major tributaries. Pallid Sturgeon can migrate upstream over 100 miles and typically spawn near the most upstream point of their migration before moving back downstream for the winter. They were listed as a federally endangered species in 1990. Population declines were associated with loss of river connectivity, alteration of habitat, and overharvesting. Ongoing conservation efforts for Pallid Sturgeon mainly take place on the Missouri River, however, the Platte River is also thought to have potential to help Pallid Sturgeon complete their life cycle.

The University of Nebraska-Lincoln started a study in January 2022 monitoring Pallid Sturgeon in the Platte River ranging from Columbus to Plattsmouth. We tagged Pallid Sturgeon with acoustic transmitters. Each transmitter has a unique identification number and sends a signal which can be detected by listening stations throughout the river marked by big, red buoys. The listening stations record the date, time, and transmitter ID, so we know which Pallid Sturgeon passed that station and when. In addition, once a month we drift down the river looking for Pallid Sturgeon in real-time to understand finer habitat use and movement. So far, we have detected over 100 Pallid Sturgeon throughout our study area and Pallid Sturgeon frequently move between the Platte and Missouri River. Pallid Sturgeon have been detected as far upstream as Columbus in the Platte River and Arlington in the Elkhorn River. Funding for this research is provided by the Platte River Recovery Implementation Program.

The NAA has allowed UNL to use our ramp at the homefront to study sturgeon.

MEET THE PALLID STURGEON

The pallid sturgeon is one of the rarest fishes in North America and was federally listed as endangered in 1990.

sturgeon can weigh up to 80 lbs and grow to be 6 feet long.

Pallid

Juveniles eat invertebrates, while adults are piscivorous, eating mainly fish.

Males mature sexually at around 10 to 15 vears old.

Today's wild pallid sturgeon

Garrison Dam was built on the

Missouri River in 1956.

After hatching, sturgeon larvae drift downstream for up to 14 days before settling in slower moving waterways.

Of the 19,000 pallid were most likely born before

sturgeon living in the Missouri & Yellowstone system, fewer than 200 were naturally produced.

Few pallid sturgeon larvae survive long enough to reproduce, which is 15 to 20 years for females. Once mature, females might only spawn every 2-3 years.


AIRBOATER'S CODE of ETHICS

- 1. I will respect the rights of all users of the recreational waterways of the state, on public waters and on adjacent private property.
- 2. I will be considerate and courteous at public vessel launch ramps and docks. In an effort to not delay others, I will launch and retrieve my vessel promptly.
- 3. I will always operate at a safe speed in posted "No Wake" zones.
- 4. When approaching the shoreline, I will be especially aware of swimmers and other water vessels near the shoreline.
- 5. I realize that my vessel's equipment, ability, weather conditions, and especially other vessel traffic should determine my vessel speed.
- 6. In case of an emergency, I will volunteer assistance.
- 7. I am aware that my vessel creates air propeller wash and will use idle speed near the shoreline and in close proximity to boat launch ramps.
- 8. I will ensure that all passengers in my vessel are equipped with safety equipment, including life vests, ear protection, eye protection, and required safety equipment.
- 9. I will avoid unnecessary disturbance of wildlife and will not enter posted "No Trespass" areas.
- 10. I will pay close attention to the engine sound levels that my vessel may create and be aware of how others on vessels and on the shoreline will react to it.
- 11. I will not litter and will bring back all trash. I will be careful in handling my fuel.
- 12. I will not interfere with or harass others.

 I realize that people will judge all airboaters by my individual actions.
