NAA Director Meeting Minutes

June 1, 2025

Meeting called to order at 1:16 PM at the Homefront, North Bend, NE. Roll call conducted, 15 out of 24 directors present.

March 2025 meeting minutes were read aloud by Jessica Fetrow. Motion to approve March minutes was made by Matt Shaw. Second by Kyle Kern. Approved unanimously.

Financial report provided to directors, reviewed and discussed. Motion to approve financial report made by Kyle Kern. Second by Randy Kassmeier. Approved unanimously.

Old Business:

Directors discussed signage at the Homefront including signage about not being liable for accidents, etc. Tabled this for now, more discussion to come.

The Homefront clean up went well and the shipping container to be used for storage at the Homefront has been placed on the property. The Lake's HOA would like us to paint the container all one color. Directors discussed moving the bin shelter over the dike, to the river side.

New Business:

Vet's Ride July 19th

- Tim Noonan is planning to donate hamburger. Wade Wagner also let the directors know that he still has steak sandwich meat the NAA could use as well. Directors decided to serve the hamburgers for the Vets Ride. Steak sandwich meat will be used for poker run.

Columbus Run July 26th

- Kick off part will be held Friday night at the Homefront, same as past years.
- Columbus Run T-shirts—may skip a year unless someone would like to pick this up and help organize. Jay Gould may have a lead and will let directors know.
- Columbus Hwy 81 Bridge—They have started to tear down the

old bridge. Randy is being told this should not impact airboat traffic until after the Columbus Run. This will be an ongoing project for the next three years. Randy is being told they are supposed to be leaving an opening, but this is not a guarantee.

- Security for boats will be available at the Columbus bridge for those staying in Columbus. The same individuals as last year will be providing security.

NAA Trailer

- Randy brought up that the enclosed trailer the NAA has is worn and may need to be replaced at some point. The directors discussed this and talked about using the shipping container to store some of the items that have previously been stored in the trailer; more to come.

Annual Meeting 2026

- The directors discussed catering options for the annual meeting. This will be voted on at the next meeting.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by Matt Shaw. Second by Jay Kern. Meeting adjourned at 1:56 PM.

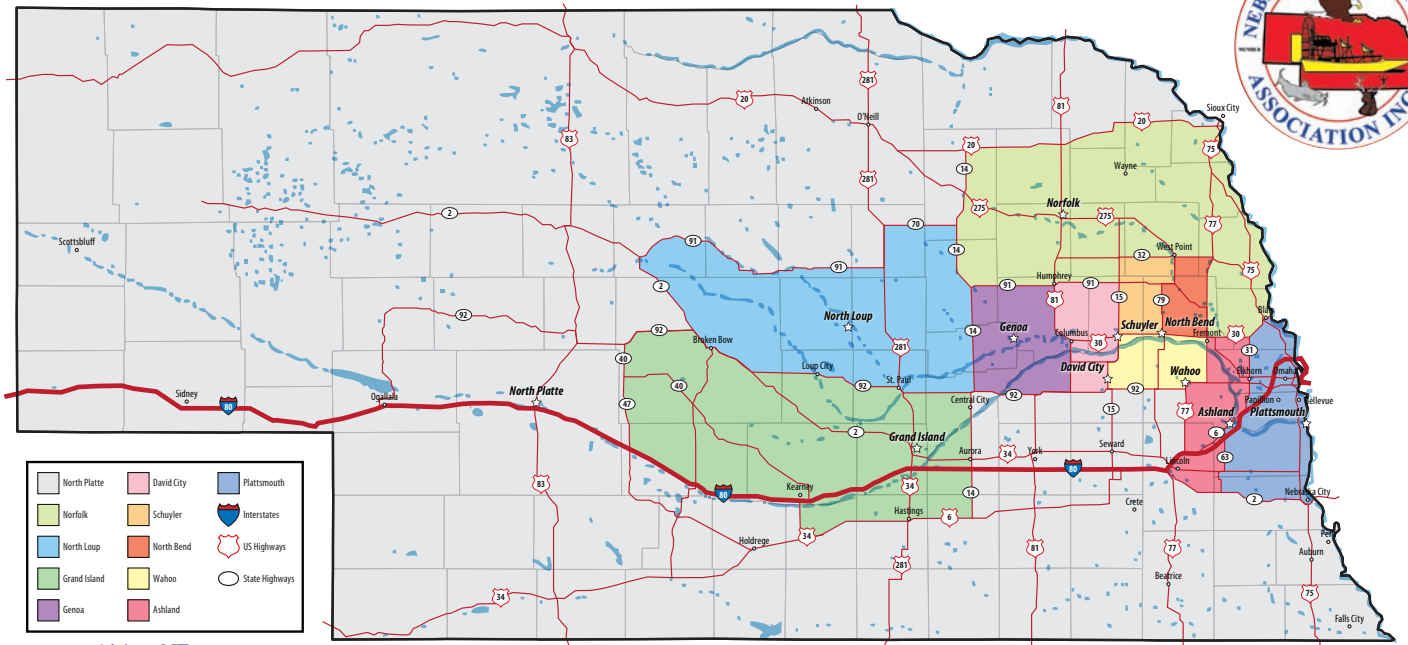

VETS RIDE!

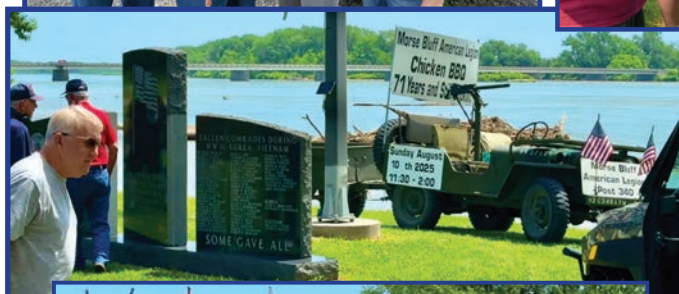
